Air Canada Contest Coupe Charles-Bruneau in Montreal 2026 Edition

Rules and Regulations

The Event :

The Coupe Charles-Bruneau Montreal is a friendly ball hockey tournament held in support of the Fondation Charles-Bruneau. The event will take place on September 26, 2026, at IGA Stadium.

Prize :

One winner will receive two Economy Class round-trip tickets for travel within North America, including Hawaii, Mexico and the Caribbean. The tickets are valid on scheduled flights operated by Air Canada, Air Canada Express and Air Canada Rouge only.

Important Dates :

Contest closes : Friday, September 25, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.

Prize draw : Saturday, September 26, 2026, during the fundraising total announcement ceremony.

Eligibility :

- The contest is open exclusively to teams that have tripled or quadrupled the minimum fundraising requirement, meaning they have raised \$15,000 or more (based on the minimum fundraising target of \$5,000).
- Individual fundraising totals are not eligible.
- Entries are allocated based on the number of registered team members (players and supporters) at the time of the Final Draft.

Entry Allocation :

- Teams that have tripled the minimum fundraising requirement (\$15,000 to \$19,999) receive one (1) entry per team member.
- Teams that have quadrupled the minimum fundraising requirement (\$20,000 or more) receive two (2) entries per team member.
- All entries are then combined into a single individual prize draw including all eligible team members.

Prize Draw :

One winner will be selected at random from all eligible entries.
